Pulaski needs your help with morning drop-off!

Dr. Baccellieri and staff seek parent volunteers to assist with a “Kiss and Go” program for morning drop-off. The purpose of this program is to safely get students out of cars and onto school grounds without drivers having to stop or double park – the things that cause traffic backup.

The school needs at least four parents each day from 8:30 – 9:15 to help kids get from their cars and onto school grounds. Parent volunteers will work with school staff to ensure that morning drop-off goes quickly and smoothly for all involved.
